Whether you’re cruising Loch Ness looking for the elusive Nessie, soaking up the history of Glen Coe, or just trying to keep your jaw off the floor as we travel through the Highlands, this is a day packed with stories, sights, and pure Scottish vibes.

Leaving the city buzz of Glasgow behind, we head north into Loch Lomond & The Trossachs National Park, a land of lochs, legends, and eye-popping scenery. From there, it’s straight into the Highlands, with a stop at Glen Coe, famous for its dramatic peaks and haunting past.

As we venture further north, you’ll catch stunning views of the Commando Monument and the Nevis Range, with a glimpse of the mighty Ben Nevis — the tallest mountain in the UK.

Next, we head to Fort Augustus, a charming village on the banks of Loch Ness. Here, you can hop on an optional boat cruise to try your luck spotting Nessie, or just relax along the Caledonian Canal.

On the way back, we’ll take you through the rugged beauty of Cairngorms National Park, wrapping up an unforgettable day before heading back to Glasgow in the evening.

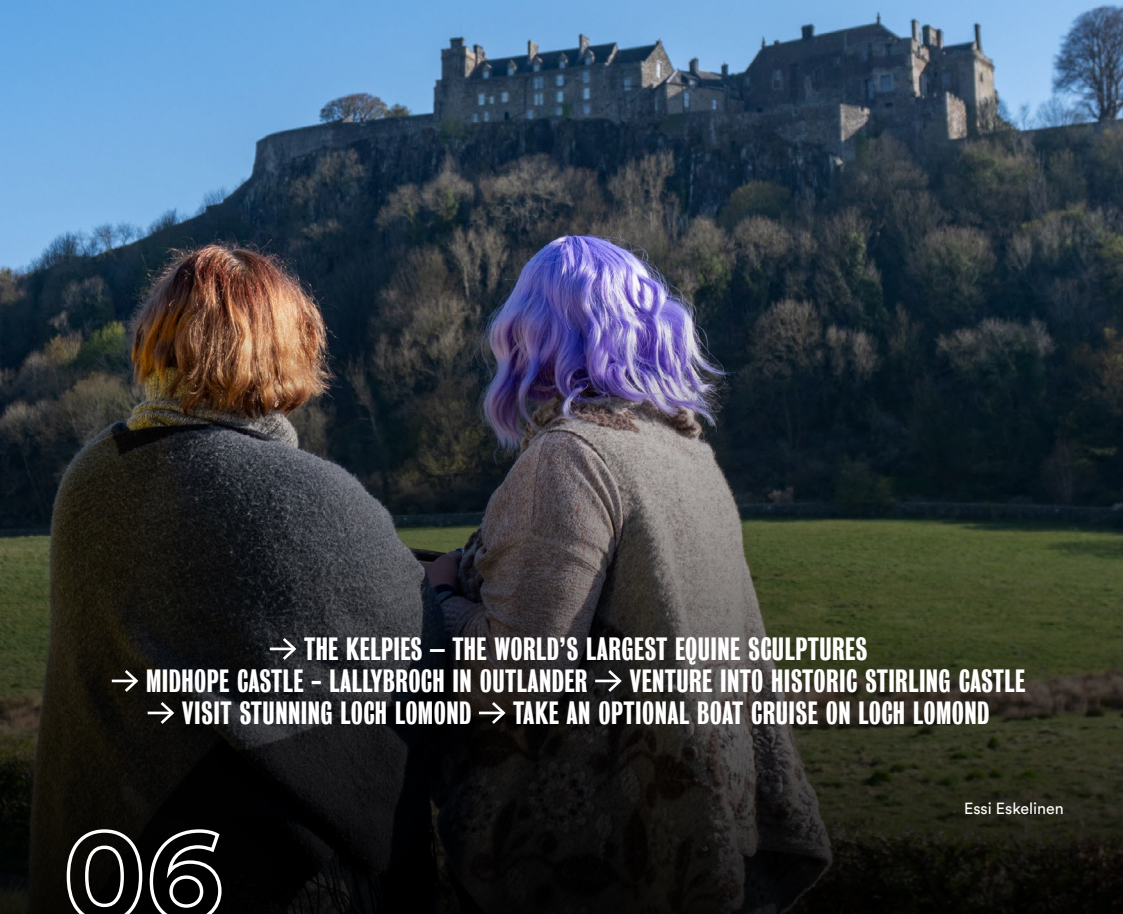

Ready for a day filled with castles, colossal horse sculptures, and a few iconic filming locations along the way? On this tour from Glasgow, we blend an Outlander favourite with classic Scottish highlights. With a local guide leading the way, you'll explore places like Midhope Castle, visit the mighty Stirling Castle, and round off the day with an optional cruise on the beautiful Loch Lomond.

We leave Glasgow and head to our first stop at the Kelpies, two giant steel horse sculptures that make for a fantastic photo opportunity.

From there, we continue to Midhope Castle, better known to Outlander fans as Lallybroch. Wander through the beautiful grounds and snap some photos — standing here feels like stepping right into the show!

Next, we make our way to Stirling Castle, where you'll have time to grab lunch and the option to explore the castle. Discover its impressive rooms and learn about the key moments that shaped Scotland's history.

Our final stop is Balloch, a small town on the edge of Loch Lomond. Stretch your legs, enjoy the scenery, or choose to join an optional cruise on the loch before we return to Glasgow, arriving in the late afternoon.

Kick off your day heading north from Glasgow to Loch Lomond, stopping in Luss to stretch your legs, snap photos, and enjoy the postcard-perfect village views.

Next, explore Inveraray, a pretty town on Loch Fyne, with its fairytale-style castle and quirky waterfront shops. Then pause at Kilchurn Castle on Loch Awe for one of Scotland's most iconic photo opportunities.

By lunchtime, arrive in Oban, the "Gateway to the Isles." Sample fresh seafood at the harbour, relax with a coffee or ice cream by the water, walk up McCaig's Tower for panoramic views, or browse the local crafts and whisky shops.

Back on the road, enter Glen Coe, with towering peaks and wild valleys that have inspired countless films – a must-see Highland landscape. Before returning to Glasgow from our epic Glen Coe and Oban day trip, we stop briefly in Tyndrum for a snack or coffee and a final chance to soak in the mountains – the perfect end to an epic Highland adventure.

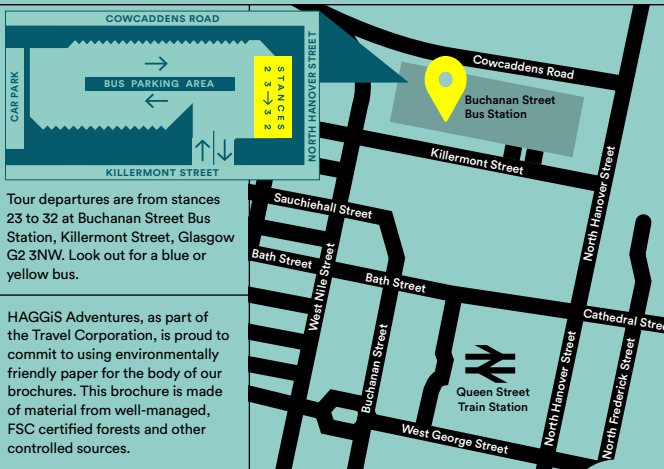
