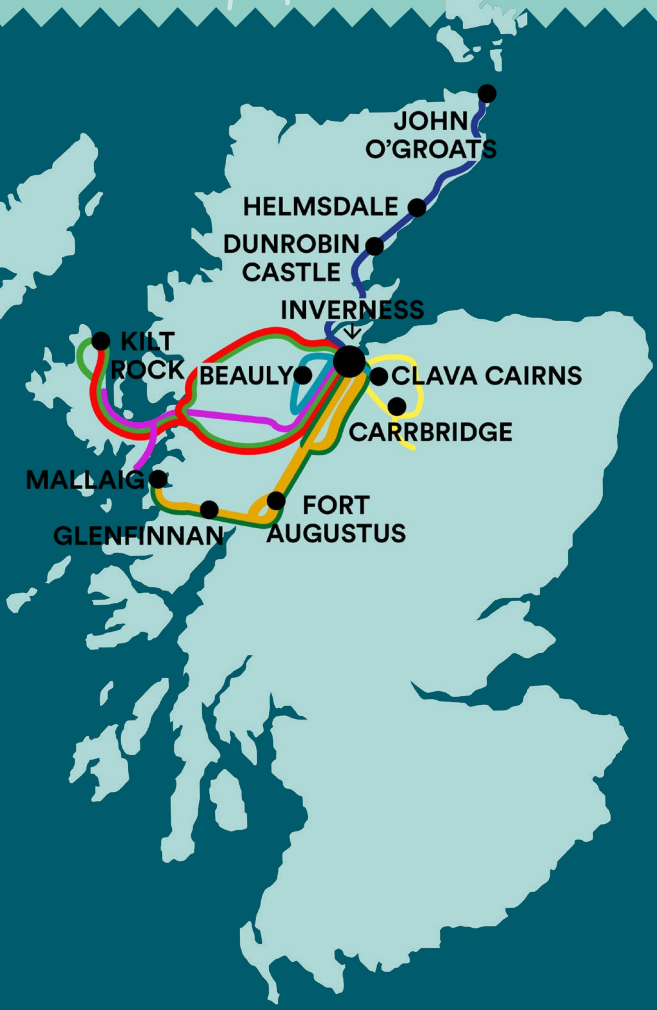

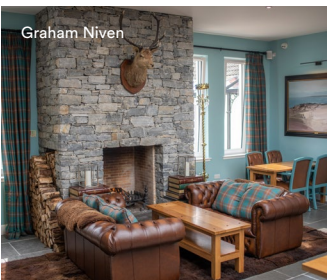

Say cheerio to Inverness and embark on a full day adventure through the rugged Highlands to the stunning Isle of Skye. Try your luck at spotting legendary Nessie as you drive along world-famous Loch Ness, and step back in time at iconic Eilean Donan Castle, before arriving on the Isle of Skye, where myths, legends and magic await!

We start bright and early and head to the home of Nessie, world-famous Loch Ness. We travel through winding Highland roads before arriving at picture-perfect Eilean Donan Castle, with the option to venture inside.

We travel northwest to meet the star of the show, Isle of Skye. After lunch at the colourful harbour of Portree, we head to the Old Man of Storr, a sight you will not forget anytime soon! Our next stop is the jaw-dropping Kilt Rock and its cascading waterfall, followed by the otherworldly landscape at the Quiraing. We return to Inverness on a scenic drive, arriving in the evening.

**Big Highland scenery, a legendary railway and a touch of wizardry. This is a full-day adventure from Inverness that throws you deep into the Highlands, with the option to hop aboard one of Scotland's most famous rail routes. On selected dates, you can cross the iconic Glenfinnan Viaduct – AKA the 'Harry Potter Bridge' – by train. Yes, the very route made famous by the Hogwarts Express in the Harry Potter film series.**

**Other departures follow the same stunning route by road, giving you more chances to join the adventure. Either way, you're in for bold scenery and a day that doesn't hold back.**



Our adventure kicks off in Inverness, where we follow the famous shores of Loch Ness and stop for a wander at Fort Augustus. From here, we head south through classic Highland scenery to the Commando Memorial, with sweeping views across the Nevis Range and towards Ben Nevis, the UK's highest mountain.

Next up is the Glenfinnan Viaduct – known to many fans (or muggles) as the "Harry Potter Bridge". Set among lochs and mountains, this is also home to the Glenfinnan Monument, built in tribute to the Jacobite clans.

We then continue west to the colourful fishing port of Mallaig. You'll have free time to explore the harbour, grab some lunch, or try fresh local seafood.

From here, your day takes one of two scenic paths:

On selected departures, you'll have the option to swap wheels for rails and hop on the train to Fort William\*. The West Highland Line is one of the most beautiful rail journeys in Scotland, taking you across the Glenfinnan Viaduct and through ever-changing Highland landscapes.

On other departures, we stay on the road and follow the Road to the Isles – a stunning coastal drive with views that easily rival the railway. This route takes us directly to Invermoriston, giving you more time to soak up the scenery along the way.

Whichever way you travel, the adventure continues at Invermoriston, a small and peaceful village split by the River Moriston and home to a charming old stone bridge.

We then make our way back towards Inverness, stopping above the atmospheric ruins of Urquhart Castle before returning in the evening, full of Highland highlights.

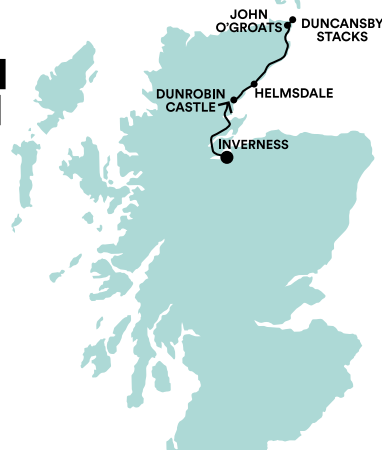
Get ready for a Highland adventure that packs a serious punch in just one day. We kick things off at Dunrobin Castle, a fairy tale beauty with grand rooms and gorgeous gardens. Then we head north to the cliffs at Duncansby Head where sea stacks rise from the waves and wildlife calls the shots. Keep your eyes open for sea life and birds along the way.

You will explore fishing villages, wild coastline, and some of the best scenery on the North Coast 500, all while soaking up stories, fresh sea air, and proper Scottish charm. It is the perfect trip for anyone short on time but hungry for big sights and bigger adventures.

Get set for a day trip that hits the far north of Scotland. We roll out of Inverness and make our way to Dunrobin Castle, a grand Highland castle with rooms so fancy you will swear the nobility only just stepped out. Wander the impressive interiors and gardens before we blaze further north.

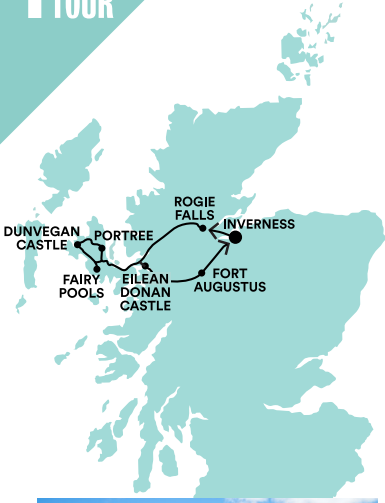
Next up is the wee village of Brora for a bite to eat, then it is onwards along the rugged coastline. Keep your eyes open for seabirds and the cute wee puffins as we visit John O'Groats, the famous end of the road spot that every traveller wants a photo with. Just along the coast we reach the dramatic sea stacks at Duncansby Head, where cliffs, waves and wildlife all fight for the spotlight.

On the journey south we swing through the fishing village of Helmsdale, a proper slice of coastal charm, before arriving back into Inverness in the evening with salty hair, big stories and even bigger grins.

**Skye in a day? Challenge accepted. This wild ride from Inverness weaves through forest trails, lochside roads, and proper Highland scenery on your way to the misty Isle. Walk the Fairy Pools, roam the halls of Dunvegan Castle (Scotland's oldest lived-in castle, no less), and grab lunch nearby before cruising on to Portree for a stroll through town. We'll swing by waterfalls, stretch our legs at epic viewpoints, and make space for coffee, banter, and the history behind it all.**

Start your Highland adventure with a leg-stretch at Rogie Falls before stopping to take in big, beautiful panoramic views over Loch Carron, then we cross the Skye Bridge to the legendary Isle of Skye. The day's standout moment? A stroll along the Fairy Pools - a stunning river trail weaving through a rocky valley under the Cuillin Mountains. After the walk, Dunvegan Castle is up next. This isn't just any castle - it's Scotland's oldest continuously inhabited one, home to the MacLeod clan for over 800 years. Exploring inside is optional, but if you do, you'll discover grand rooms filled with fascinating artefacts, including the famous Fairy Flag, a mysterious banner said to bring good fortune when unfurled in battle.

After lunch in Dunvegan, we head to colourful Portree for a wander, then stop for photos at Sligachan Bridge, where you'll get epic views of the Black Cuillin. The return journey packs in more stunners like Eilean Donan Castle and Urquhart Castle on Loch Ness before rolling back into Inverness in the late evening.

# WILDSKYE COMMUNITY & OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

**Feel like shaking things up a bit? Join us for a trip that blends adventure with a splash of positive impact! We're teaming up with the Sleat Community Trust for some hands-on action in Tormore Forest – picture mornings of tree planting, trail building, and fixing up what needs fixing. In the afternoons, you'll be chasing waterfalls, soaking up jaw-dropping views, swapping stories with locals, and even learning a wee bit of Gaelic. It's your chance to roll up your sleeves, connect with awesome people, and leave Scotland a tad better than you found it.**

**DAY 1 | INVERNESS → PORTREE**

We depart Inverness and drive through awe-inspiring scenery along Loch Ness, before stopping at Eilean Donan Castle. After lunch in Portree, the main town of the Isle of Skye, we explore the striking Kilt Rock, Old Man of Storr, and the Quiraing. We settle in at The Skye Inn in the evening, where you can expect a comfy, personal stay for four nights. Feel right at home! (Overnight: Portree)

**DAY 2 | ISLE OF SKYE**

After a hearty Scottish breakfast we meet Sleat Community Trust in Tormore Forest and get stuck into a morning of tree planting and path repair. After lunch, we go for a scenic walk by the infamous Fairy Pools, a series of crystal-clear waterfalls surrounded by the staggering peaks of the Cuillin Mountains. (Overnight: Portree)

**DAY 3 | ISLE OF SKYE**

Our adventure continues with a spectacular morning in the forest. In the afternoon, try your tongue at the spectacular National Centre for Gaelic Language and Culture, Sabhal Mòr Ostaig. Throw yourself into some basic phrases and try to converse like a true Scot with this legendary taster session. (Overnight: Portree)

**DAY 4 | ISLE OF SKYE**

Our physical effort this morning is balanced with a laid-back afternoon exploring Sleat and its hidden beaches and rocky shorelines, art galleries and local shops – the perfect opportunity to pick up a souvenir of your time on Skye. (Overnight: Portree)

**DAY 5 | ISLE OF SKYE → INVERNESS**

After a morning of volunteering we head for a well-earned dram at the island distillery of Torabhaig. Take the optional tour to discover how Scotland's 'water of life' is made and toast to hard work, new friends and making a difference – Sláinte! The time has come to bid farewell to our newfound pals as we return to Inverness in the evening.

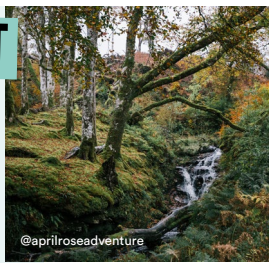

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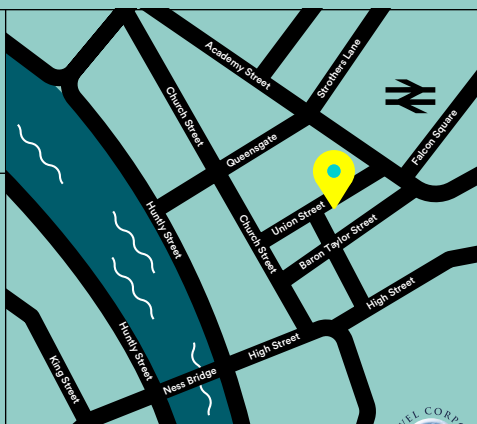
