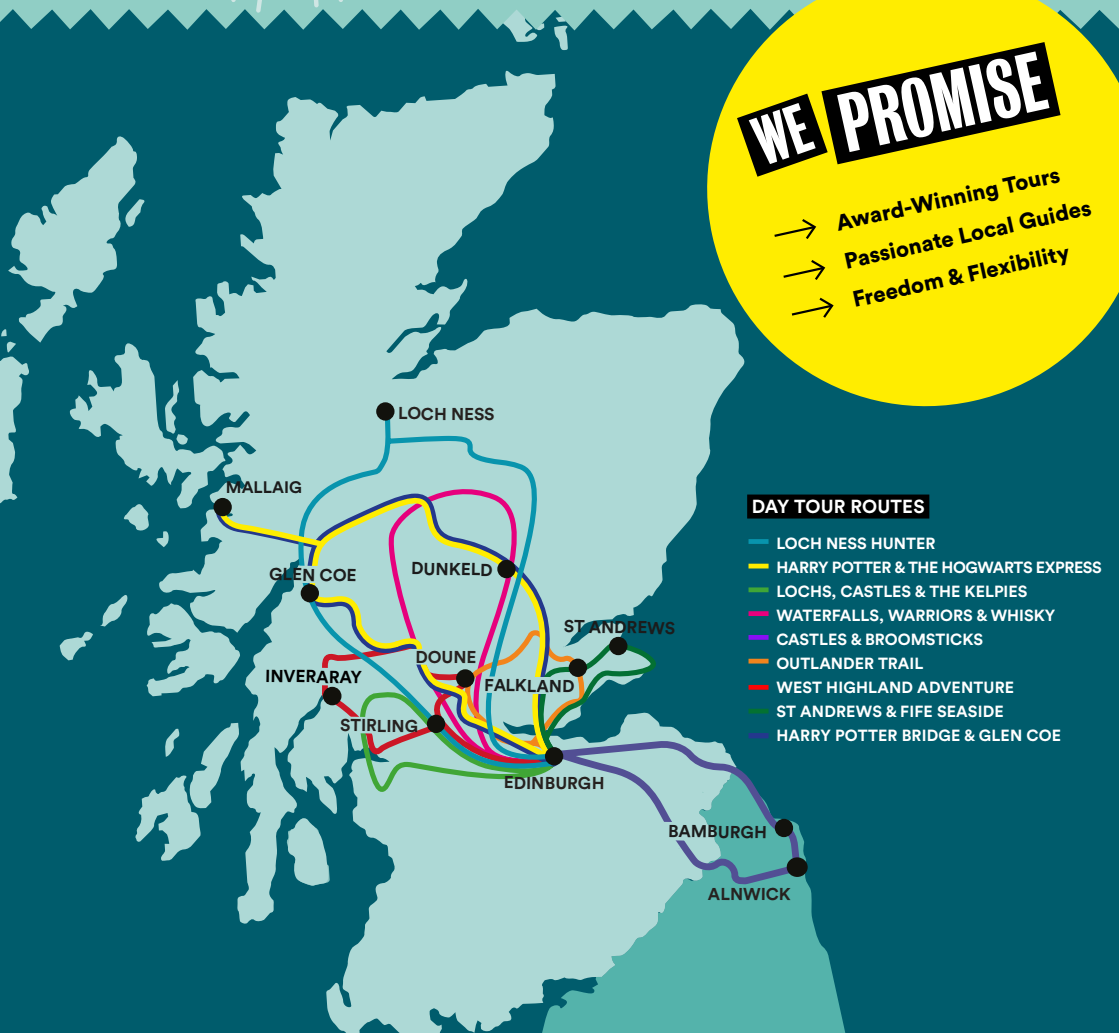

We leave Edinburgh and head northwest through Stirlingshire, once William Wallace's home. We visit Doune Castle, famed for appearing in *Outlander*, *Game of Thrones*, and *Monty Python and the Holy Grail!* Moving on, we explore Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park, boasting majestic mountains, expansive lochs, and historic castles.

We make a stop at Loch Fyne for a wee loch-side stroll, followed by lunch in Inveraray with the option to visit Inveraray Castle *open Thursday - Monday. Brave souls can delve into Inveraray Jail's 19th-century prisoner experience, hailed as one of the world's best-preserved courtrooms and prisons!

Next, we enjoy magical views of the Arrochar Alps at the Rest and Be Thankful viewpoint before reaching Luss, a conservation village renowned for its stunningly beautiful Scottish architecture. Our awesome day concludes as we return to Edinburgh in the evening.

Get ready for a full throttle Highland escape as we roll out of Edinburgh and head north to see the famous Glenfinnan Viaduct, also known as the Harry Potter bridge. Our first stop is Pitlochry, a cute Highland town that is ideal for a quick coffee and a stretch before the scenery cranks up.

We continue toward the Nevis range where we pass under the shadow of the UK's highest mountain. Then comes the big moment. Glenfinnan Viaduct. This iconic curve of stone has become a favourite for every wizard loving traveller, and seeing it feels like stepping into a story.

Next, we reach Mallaig, a salty aired harbour village where you can grab lunch and chill by the water. The return journey brings even more drama as we pass through the epic landscapes of Glen Coe, a place filled with towering mountains and legendary atmosphere.

By the time we reach Edinburgh again, you will have tired legs, a happy heart, and a backpack full of Highland memories.

Pack your essentials and travel back to the 18th century on an *Outlander* themed adventure to charming villages and iconic historic attractions: a dream day out for any *Outlander* fan!

We can't guarantee any time travel through standing stones, but your guide will immerse you in real-life tales from the past which inspired Diana Gabaldon's world-famous books. When you experience these stunning locations, you'll understand why they were chosen to feature in the hit TV series.

We start the day in Edinburgh and head to Midhope Castle*, the *Outlander* filming location for Lallybroch. Next, we visit Doune Castle, or Castle Leoch to *Outlander* fans. As one of the best-preserved medieval castles in Scotland, it has also appeared in *Game of Thrones*, *Outlaw King* and *Monty Python & the Holy Grail*.

Over in the ancient Kingdom of Fife, we visit Falkland, the setting for 1940's Inverness. Explore the quaint streets or chase Jamie's ghostly figure around the village square. Afterwards, we travel to colourful Culross, which starred as Cranesmuir, where Claire and Geillis Duncan were accused of witchcraft.

Saving the best 'til last, our final stop is at Blackness Castle, the fictional setting for Fort William in *Outlander*, home to Captain Jack Randall's worst acts of violence. We get the chance to view the jaw-dropping Forth Bridges before we return to the capital in the early evening. The perfect end to an awesome day!

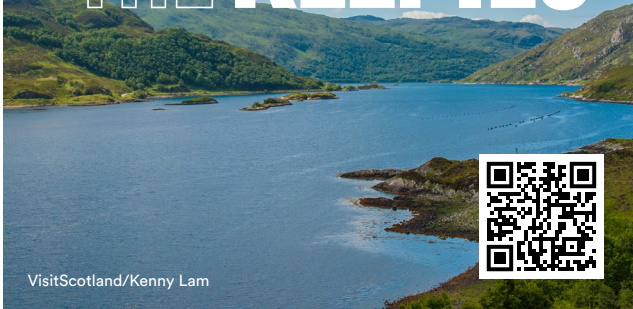

A perfect wee taster of Scotland - this tour mixes up the world's largest horse sculptures, The Kelpies, the seriously stunning beauty of Loch Lomond (the biggest loch or lake in the whole of Britain and inspiration to poets and painters) and The Trossachs National Park with the savage history of Stirling Castle where kings were murdered and rebellions started.

We depart Edinburgh in the morning and head west towards Falkirk where you'll have the chance to 'ooh', 'aah', and, um, 'nay', at the world's largest equine sculptures, the Kelpies. Each 30-metre-high horse head sculpture is made from 300 tonnes of structural steel and designed by Scottish sculptor, Andy Scott.

Our adventure takes us to the 'Bonnie Banks of Loch Lomond' for woodland walks and stunning views. We stop at the village of Balmaha and admire Scotland's most southerly Munro, Ben Lomond, on the way.

The afternoon takes you to one of the largest and most significant castles in Scotland, both architecturally and historically. Stirling Castle sits atop Castle Hill and was central to William Wallace and Robert the Bruce's Wars of Independence. After a day full of exploration, we return to Edinburgh early evening.

After soaking in the stunning views of the Sma' Glen, we'll hit The Hermitage forest in Perthshire for a beautiful woodland walk through rivers and waterfalls. We wrap up our day in the charming riverside village of Dunkeld to grab a local treat or two. We return to Edinburgh in the early evening hours.

Spend a day discovering Scotland's east coast in a way that's full of stories and seaside charm. You'll wander through the wee fishing village of Anstruther, explore St Andrews at your own pace, and uncover its castle, cathedral, or legendary Old Course. Stop in Falkland for a glimpse of royal history and an Outlander filming spot, finishing with the dramatic Forth Bridge.

We hit the road from Edinburgh in the morning, aiming east along the Fife coastline. The drive here is full of surprises, passing by epic coastal scenery, colourful boats, and stone cottages that seem frozen in time.

First stop: Anstruther. It's a working fishing village with history in every nook. Watch the locals haul in their catch, wander the pier, and maybe enjoy some fish and chips while swapping stories with your fellow travellers.

Next up, St Andrews. Here you can go your own way: visit St Andrews Castle and peek into its infamous Bottle Dungeon or take a stroll to St Andrews Cathedral. You can climb St Rule's Tower for sweeping views or just wander among the ruins to soak up the atmosphere around the cathedral's graveyard. Golf fans can swing by the Old Course, the world's oldest course and a must-see for anyone into the game.

On the way back, we stop in Falkland, Scotland's first conservation village. Wander past restored cottages and visit Falkland Palace, once home to Scottish royalty. Outlander fans might recognise the village square from the show's first episode.

Before we head home, we cross the Forth Bridge, a striking UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Scotland's most impressive engineering feats. Your day wraps up in the early evening, leaving plenty of time to chill and head out for some dinner in town after.

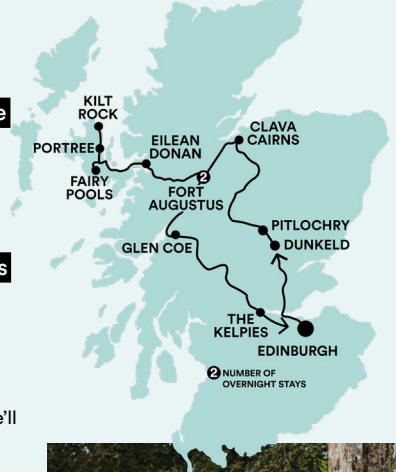

Head to the north and west of our majestic country to discover some of the sexiest scenery on the planet. We encounter famous gems like Eilean Donan Castle, Glen Coe and mysterious Loch Ness, all part of the Highland's rich heritage and natural beauty.

There's also a day exploring the breathtaking Isle of Skye, including the Fairy Pools, and all the Scottish stories, myths and legends you can imagine!



DAY ONE | EDINBURGH → LOCH NESS

We begin our Wild Skye & Loch Ness tour as we leave Edinburgh behind and cross the Forth Road Bridge on our way through to Dunkeld. Later we'll do a woodland walk before lunch in Pitlochry.

After a wander around Portree, we arrive back to Fort Augustus in the evening. (Overnight: Fort Augustus)

DAY THREE | PORTREE → EDINBURGH

Leaving the Great Glen, we pass under Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain. Our route takes us through the rugged landscape of Glen Coe, before we cross the Rannoch Moor, showing you yet again another side of Scotland.

Before we arrive back to Edinburgh we make a stop at the Kelpies, the world's largest horse sculpture, designed by Scottish sculptor Andy Scott. After an epic three days, our tour returns to Edinburgh in the early evening.

Spend 3 action-packed days diving headfirst into the Highlands, with enough time to really experience two of Scotland's biggest legends. Experience the dark waters of Loch Ness one night, then explore wildly beautiful Isle of Skye the next. The journey itself is half the fun, winding through dramatic landscapes like Glen Coe, stopping at dreamy spots such as the Fairy Pools, and snapping photos at stunning Eilean Donan Castle. DAY ONE | EDINBURGH → LOCH NESS

On your way to Skye you'll stop at a viewpoint looking out over Eilean Donan Castle, perfectly placed where three sea lochs meet.

Once you cross the Skye Bridge, you travel beneath the mighty Cuillin Mountains before pulling on your walking shoes for a visit to the famous Fairy Pools.

From there, you will head to Portree, Skye's lively harbour town, with time to grab lunch, wander the waterfront, and soak up island life.

In the afternoon, you will visit the Old Man of Storr, a towering rock formation, then finish the day at Kilt Rock, where a waterfall plunges straight down into the sea. (Overnight: Portree)

DAY THREE | ISLE OF SKYE → EDINBURGH

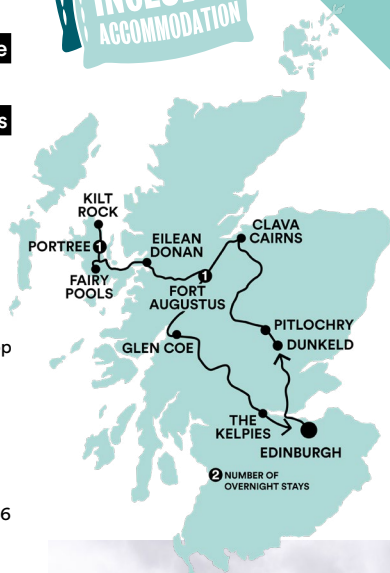
We make our way through the legendary Great Glen, with a stop at the iconic Commando Memorial. This powerful spot looks straight out over the mountains and pays tribute to the elite soldiers who trained here during WWII. Next up: Glen Coe, one of Scotland's most jaw-dropping spots. You'll journey across the vast wilderness of Rannoch Moor, before winding your way through the forests, lochs, and postcard-worthy scenery of Loch Lomond & The Trossachs National Park.

Our last stop is The Kelpies – two colossal steel horse head sculptures rising from the ground. An unforgettable finale to an epic Highland adventure.
